

You will shortly receive from the Secretary of the Holy Synod, His Eminence, Archbishop Michael, formal notice of recent actions taken by the Holy Synod with respect to the Diocese of New England. Per the statute of the Orthodox Church in America, the office of the bishop of the Diocese of New England was declared vacant and I informed the Holy Synod that I will serve as the Locum Tenens of the Diocese for the immediate future.

As Locum Tenens, my primary responsibility is to see to the election of a new bishop and to maintain the widowed diocese in the interim period. While I will attend to other administrative and pastoral matters, decisions during the period of a locum tenency are typically considered provisional until such a time as a new archpastor is elected. I look forward to working with your Chancellor, Archpriest John Kreta, as we proceed with the good work of the diocese, and begin the process of identifying a candidate to lead the Diocese of New England.

In this interim period, I will be available to the clergy and the faithful of the diocese through the diocesan chancellor. I also look forward to being with you at your diocesan assembly in October and to hear from you concerning the current life and future prospects of the Diocese of New England.
