TONE 1

26th Sunday after Pentecost (12th of Luke) Sunday of the Forefathers

"Lord I Call..." Tone 1

Lord, I call upon You, hear me! Hear me, O Lord!
Lord, I call upon You, hear me!
Receive the voice of my prayer, when I call upon You!//
Hear me, O Lord!

Let my <u>prayer</u> arise in Your sight as <u>in</u>cense, and <u>let</u> the lifting <u>up</u> of my hands be an <u>eve</u>ning <u>sac</u>rifice!// Hear me, O Lord!

V. (10) Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Your Name!

Tone 1 *(for the Resurrection)*

Ac<u>cept</u> our evening prayers, O <u>ho</u>ly Lord! Grant us re<u>mis</u>sion of sins,// for You alone have manifested the Resurrection to the world.

V. (9) The righteous will surround me, for You will deal bountifully with me.

En<u>cir</u>cle <u>Zi</u>on and surround her, O <u>peo</u>ple!
Give <u>glo</u>ry in her to the One Who <u>rose</u> from the dead!
For <u>He</u> is <u>our</u> God,//
Who has delivered us from our trans<u>gres</u>sions!

V. (8) Out of the depths I cry to You, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice!

Come, O people, let us hymn and fall <u>down</u> before Christ, <u>glo</u>rifying His Resur<u>rec</u>tion from the dead! For <u>He</u> is <u>our</u> God,// Who has delivered the world from the <u>En</u>emy's deceit!

V. (7) Let Your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!

(Resurrection stichera by Anatolius)

Be glad, O heavens!
Sound trumpets, O foundations of the earth!
Sing in gladness, O mountains!
Behold Emmanuel has nailed our sins to the Cross!
Granting life, He has slain death.//
He has resurrected Adam as the Lover of man.

V. (6) If You, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You.

Let us praise Him

Who voluntarily was crucified in the <u>flesh</u> for our sake.

He <u>suf</u>fered, was buried, but <u>rose</u> from the dead.

By Orthodoxy confirm Your Church, O Christ.//

Grant peace for our life as the gracious <u>Lov</u>er of man.

V. (5) For Your Name's sake I wait for You, O Lord. My soul has waited for Your word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

We <u>stand</u> before Your life-bearing tomb unworthily, O <u>Christ</u> God, offering glory to Your ineffable com<u>passion</u>. You have ac<u>cept</u>ed the Cross and death, O <u>sin</u>less One// to grant Resurrection to the world as the Lover of man.

V. (4) From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord!

Tone 8 (for the Forefathers) (The Paradise of Eden)

Today, as we celebrate the Forefathers' memory, let us the faithful praise Christ the Redeemer, Who magnified them in all the nations! He is the Lord Who does wondrous deeds, for He is powerful and mighty! Through them He has shown us the rod of His strength: she is Mary, the only pure and Virgin Maiden of God. From her Christ blossomed,// bringing forth life, eternal salvation, and unending bliss for all.

V. (3) For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities.

O <u>Mas</u>ter, You delivered the Holy <u>Youths</u> from the fire, and Daniel from the mouths of <u>li</u>ons; You blessed Abraham, Isaac, Your <u>ser</u>vant, and <u>Ja</u>cob, his son; You consented to become like us by being <u>born</u> of their seed, to be crucified and <u>bur</u>ied, in order to save our <u>Fore</u>fathers, who <u>fell</u> of old. Thus You crushed the <u>bonds</u> of death and raised with Yourself all the dead of <u>ages</u> past,// who worship You, O Christ, King of the <u>ages</u>.

V. (2) Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!

Walking amidst the flames as in a gentle shower of rain, the godly Youths exulted in the dew of the Spirit.

By this they mystically prefigured the Trinity and Christ's incarnation. Wise through faith, they quenched the power of fire.

So also the righteous Daniel stopped the mouths of lions.

Through their intercessions we beseech You, O Savior and Lover of man: Deliver us from the unquenchable and eternal fire,// and make us worthy of Your heavenly Kingdom!

V. (1) For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever.

Standing in a furnace of flaming fire as though in dew, the Holy Youths mystically prefigured Your coming from a Virgin, by which we are illumined but not consumed.

So also the righteous Daniel, glorious among the Prophets, clearly revealed Your divine Second Coming when he cried out: "I saw thrones set up, and the Judge was seated, and the river of fire flowed before Him."//

By their intercessions save us from this fire, O Christ our Master!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit;

Tone 6 *(for the Forefathers, by Anatolius)*

Today, let us the <u>faithful</u> acclaim all the Fathers be<u>fore</u> the Law: Abraham, the <u>friend</u> of God, Isaac, born of the <u>promise</u>, Jacob and the twelve <u>Pa</u>triarchs, honoring with these the gentle <u>Da</u>vid, and Daniel, the <u>Prophet</u> of Desires,

and the three Youths who changed the <u>fur</u>nace into dew. Let us ask forgiveness of <u>Christ</u> our God,// Who is <u>glo</u>rified in His saints!

now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Tone 1 (*Theotokion – Dogmatikon*)

Let us <u>praise</u> the Virgin <u>Mary!</u>
The gate of heaven, the <u>glory</u> of the world!
The <u>song</u> of the angels, the beauty of the <u>faithful!</u>
She was born of <u>man</u>, yet gave <u>birth</u> to God!
She was re<u>vealed</u> as the heaven, as the temple of the <u>God</u>head!
She destroyed the wall of <u>en</u>mity!
She com<u>menced</u> the peace; she opened the <u>King</u>dom!
Since she is <u>our foundation</u> of faith,
our defender is the <u>Lord</u> Whom she bore!
Courage! Courage! O <u>Peo</u>ple of God!
For <u>Christ</u> will destroy our <u>en</u>emies//
since He is all <u>pow</u>erful.

Tone 1 (for the Resurrection)

We have been <u>freed</u> from <u>suf</u>ferings by Your <u>suf</u>fering, O Christ. <u>We</u> have been delivered from cor<u>rup</u>tion by Your <u>Res</u>ur<u>rec</u>tion.// O Lord, <u>glo</u>ry to You!

V. The Lord is King; He is robed in majesty!

Let creation rejoice!
Let the heavens be glad!
Let the nations clap their hands with gladness,
for Christ our Savior has nailed our sins to the Cross.
Slaying death, He has given life.//
He has resurrected fallen Adam as the Lover of man.

V. For He has established the world, so that it shall never be moved.

As <u>King</u> of <u>heav</u>en and earth,
You were voluntarily crucified in Your <u>love</u> for man.

<u>Hell</u> was angered when it <u>met</u> You below.

Adam rose seeing You, the Creator, <u>un</u>der the earth.
O <u>won</u>der! How has the Life of all <u>tast</u>ed death?

You enlightened the <u>world</u> which cries://

Come all who <u>love</u> the feast, let us praise in psalms the assembly of the <u>Fore</u>fathers: Adam, our first <u>Fa</u>ther, Enoch, Noah, Mel<u>chizedek</u>, Abraham, Isaac and <u>Ja</u>cob; and those who came <u>after</u> the Law: Moses, Aaron, <u>Joshua</u>, Samuel and <u>Da</u>vid, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel and <u>Dan</u>iel, and with them the Twelve <u>Proph</u>ets: Elijah, Elisha, and <u>all</u> the rest, Zachariah and John the <u>Bap</u>tist: all those who pro<u>claimed</u> Christ,// the Life and Resur<u>rec</u>tion of the <u>hu</u>man race!

now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Tone 3 (Theotokion)

By the will of the <u>Fa</u>ther, without seed, of the Holy Spirit you conceived the <u>Son</u> of God. He was born of the Father before eternity without a <u>mother</u>, but now for our sake He came from you without a <u>fa</u>ther!// Do not cease entreating Him to de<u>liver</u> our <u>souls</u> from harm!
