#### TONE 5

#### "Lord I Call..." Tone 5

Lord, I call upon You, <u>hear</u> me! <u>Hear</u> me, O Lord! <u>Lord</u>, I call upon You, <u>hear</u> me! Receive the <u>voice</u> of my prayer, when I <u>call</u> upon You!// <u>Hear me</u>, O Lord!

Let my prayer arise in Your sight as <u>in</u>cense, and <u>let</u> the lifting <u>up</u> of my hands be an <u>eve</u>ning <u>sac</u>rifice!// <u>Hear me</u>, O Lord!

V. (10) Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Your Name!
V. (9) The righteous will surround me, for You will deal bountifully with me.

**Tone 5** *(for the Resurrection)* 

By Your <u>pre</u>cious <u>Cross</u>, O Christ, You have put the <u>dev</u>il to shame. By Your Resur<u>rec</u>tion, You have blunted the <u>sting</u> of sin and <u>saved</u> us from the <u>gates</u> of death.// We glorify You, O <u>on</u>ly be<u>got</u>ten One.

V. (8) Out of the depths I cry to You, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice!

<u>Christ</u> was led as a sheep to the <u>slaughter</u> in order to grant Resurrection to the <u>hu</u>man race. The <u>princes</u> of hell were <u>frightened</u> by this, for the <u>gates</u> of sorrow were <u>lifted</u>. Christ the King of glory had <u>en</u>tered, <u>say</u>ing to those in <u>chains</u>: "Go forth!"// And to those in <u>darkness</u>: "<u>Come</u> to the light!"

V. (7) Let Your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!

<u>O</u> great <u>won</u>der! The Creator of the invisible suffered in the flesh in His <u>love</u> for man and <u>rose</u> again im<u>mor</u>tal. <u>Come</u>, O sons of <u>na</u>tions, let us <u>wor</u>ship Him, for de<u>livered</u> from error by His com<u>pas</u>sion,// we have learned to sing of one <u>God</u> in three <u>Per</u>sons!

**V.** (6) If You, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You.

(Resurrection stichera by Anatolius)

We <u>offer</u> You our evening <u>wor</u>ship, O never <u>set</u>ting Light, Who <u>came</u> in these last days to the <u>world</u> in the flesh; Who <u>ev</u>en descended to hell to dispel its <u>dark</u>ness. Who has revealed the light of Resurrection to the <u>na</u>tions.// Glory to You, O <u>Lord</u> and <u>Giv</u>er of light!

**V.** (5) For Your Name's sake I wait for You, O Lord. My soul has waited for Your word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

We <u>glo</u>rify the Leader of our sal<u>va</u>tion; by His Resur<u>rec</u>tion from the dead, the <u>world</u> was <u>saved</u> from deceit. The as<u>sem</u>bly of Angels rejoices as the deceit of demons is <u>ov</u>erthrown.// Fallen Adam <u>ris</u>es as the <u>dev</u>il falls.

**V.** (4) *From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord!* 

The <u>guards</u> were instructed by the <u>law</u>less ones: "Hide the rising of Christ, take <u>mon</u>ey and say: 'The <u>body</u> was stolen from the tomb while <u>we</u> were asleep.'" But <u>who</u> has heard of a body being <u>sto</u>len, a body embalmed and <u>naked</u>, with its <u>grave</u> clothes left be<u>hind</u> in the tomb? Do <u>not</u> be de<u>ceived</u>, O Jews, study the words of the Prophets and <u>un</u>derstand:// Christ is the Redeemer of the <u>world</u> and all <u>pow</u>erful! **V. (3)** For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities.

**Tone 4**(for Ven. Macarius)

(You have given a sign)

Desiring blessedness that passes under<u>standing</u>, you took abstinence for luxury, O in<u>spired</u> one, <u>pov</u>erty for wealth, lack of possessions as true a<u>bund</u>ance and humility for <u>glo</u>ry. As you intended, you reached your heart's de<u>sire</u>, O Ma<u>car</u>ius,// and now you dwell in the <u>man</u>sions of the saints.

V. (2) Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!

You completed the course of ascetic life without <u>wav</u>ering, and you kept the faith, O <u>Fa</u>ther. Thus you <u>gained</u> a crown of righteousness pre<u>pared</u> for you by Christ, Who grants the prizes of <u>vic</u>tory and bestows the gifts and re<u>wards</u> of <u>la</u>bors.// Pray now, O God-bearer, that we also may <u>run</u> this course!

**V**. (1) For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever.

You denied yourself every pleasure, O divinely-<u>wise</u> one; you pummeled your body and embittered your <u>sens</u>es through <u>labors</u> of hardship and <u>ab</u>stinence, through long-suffering in temptations and patience in ad<u>ver</u>sities. In their place you have re<u>ceived</u> un<u>end</u>ing joy,// everlasting delight and ineffable <u>glo</u>ry.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit;

Tone 8 *(for Ven. Macarius)* 

Rejoice, O Egypt! You brought forth a great protector, Macarius the <u>bless</u>ed, who shone with the wisdom of the <u>Holy Spir</u>it, transcending all asceticism with his virtuous <u>way</u> of life. We offer him as mediator, be<u>seeching him</u>// that he may intercede with Christ for the sal<u>va</u>tion of our souls

now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

### **Tone 5** (*Theotokion – Dogmatikon*)

In the Red Sea of old,

a type of the Virgin Bride was pre<u>fig</u>ured. There <u>Moses divided the waters;</u> here <u>Gabriel assisted in the mir</u>acle. There Israel crossed the sea without <u>getting wet</u>, here the <u>Virgin gave birth to <u>Christ</u> without seed. After <u>Is</u>rael's passage, the sea remained im<u>passable</u>; after Emmanuel's birth, the Virgin remained a <u>Virgin</u>. O <u>ev</u>er-existing God Who ap<u>peared</u> as Man,// O <u>Lord</u>, have <u>mer</u>cy on us!</u>

#### **Tone 5** *(for the Resurrection)*

We <u>magnify</u> You in <u>songs</u> of praise, O incarnate Christ and <u>Sav</u>ior. By ac<u>cept</u>ing the Cross and <u>death</u> for our sake, as the <u>Lord</u> and <u>Lov</u>er of man, You overthrew the <u>gates</u> of hell,// and arose on the <u>third</u> day, <u>sav</u>ing our souls.

V. The Lord is King; He is robed in majesty!

By being <u>pierced</u> in the side, O <u>Lov</u>er of man, You have poured out drops of life and sal<u>va</u>tion for all. By ac<u>cept</u>ing death in the flesh, You have granted us immor<u>tal</u>ity. You have <u>freed</u> us by being <u>placed</u> in the tomb, and have resurrected us with Yourself in <u>glo</u>ry, as God.// Glory to You, O <u>Lord</u> and <u>Lov</u>er of man!

**V**. For He has established the world, so that it shall never be moved.

Your cruci<u>fix</u>ion and descent into hell are awesome, O <u>Lov</u>er of man. You have captured it, releasing the ancient <u>pris</u>oners. You have <u>opened Paradise and giv</u>en it to us. <u>Grant us purification of sins</u>, who glorify Your Resurrection on the <u>third</u> day! Make us <u>wor</u>thy of <u>Paradise</u>// and <u>save</u> us, O <u>Lov</u>er of man!

V. Holiness befits Your house, O Lord, forevermore!

For our <u>sake</u>, You accepted <u>death</u> in the flesh, to rise from the dead on the <u>third</u> day. <u>Heal</u> us from our earthly <u>passions</u>, and re<u>store</u> us from our evil trans<u>gres</u>sions;// and <u>save</u> us, O <u>Lov</u>er of man!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit;

Tone 6 (Ven. Macarius)

The sound of your teachings has gone out into <u>all</u> the earth, O venerable Father Ma<u>car</u>ius. Therefore you have found the reward of your labors in the <u>heav</u>ens. You destroyed the hosts of <u>de</u>mons and reached the ranks of Angels, whose life you blamelessly <u>fol</u>lowed. Since you boldness before <u>Christ</u> our God,// entreat <u>peace</u> for our souls!

Tone 6(Theotokion)

My Maker and Redeemer, <u>Christ</u> the Lord, was born of you, O most pure <u>Virgin</u>. By accepting my nature, He freed Adam from his <u>an</u>cient curse. Unceasingly we magnify you as the <u>Mother of God!</u> Rejoice, O ce<u>les</u>tial Joy! Rejoice, O <u>Lady</u>:// the Protection, Intercession and Sal<u>va</u>tion of our souls!
