Priest: Prayer during Coronavirus

Prayer to the Lord of Hosts:

Reader: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Priest: Holy God, Who created all things through Your Son with the cooperation of the Holy Spirit;. (Celebrant Crosses himself)

Priest: Holy Mighty, through Whom we know the Father; and through Whom the Holy Spirit came to dwell in the world; (Celebrant Crosses himself)

Priest: Holy Immortal, Comforting Spirit, Who proceed from the Father and rest in the Son. O Holy Trinity, glory to You!" (Celebrant Crosses himself)

Reader: The heavenly choir sings to You, and cries: Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of Hosts; heaven and earth are full of Your glory.

Verse: We have seen the true light! We have received the Heavenly Spirit!

Reader: The heavenly choir sings to You, and cries: Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of Hosts; heaven and earth are full of Your glory.

Verse: We have found the true faith, worshipping the undivided trinity, who has saved us!

Reader: The choir of holy Angels, Archangels, with all the Powers of heaven, sing Your praises and do cry: Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of Hosts; heaven and earth are full of Your glory.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. Now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Choir: Symbol of Faith

Priest: Prayer of Forgivingness:

O God, remit, pardon and forgive our sins, whether voluntary or involuntary, whether by words or deeds, whether in knowledge or ignorance, whether by day or night, whether in mind or thought; forgive us all these, for You are good and love mankind.

Choir: The Lord's Prayer

Priest: Exclamation

Reader: Lord have mercy (12x)

Priest: All-holy Trinity, Mighty one in essence, Kingdom undivided, origin of all good things, be graciously inclined also to us sinners. Establish us; give understanding to our hearts, and purge away all our vileness. Enlighten our minds, that we may glorify, sing praises, and adore You, and say:

Choir: One is Holy. One is the Lord, Jesus Christ, to the glory of God the Father. Amen.

Choir: Blessed be the Name of the Lord, henceforth and forever more. (3x)

Reader: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Reader: Psalm 33

Choir: "Rejoice, O Queen! Glory of mothers and virgins ..."

Priest: Glory to You, O Christ our God and our sure hope, Glory to You.

Choir: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen. Lord have mercy (3x). Father bless.

Priest: Festal Dismissal

Choir: Amen.
