SUNDAY, MARCH 22

TONE 7

Third Sunday of Lent. Veneration of the Cross. Hieromartyr Basil of Ancyra.

(Before the vigil: the celebrant transfers the precious Cross to the Holy Altar Table, accompanied by the singing of the Troparion, "O Lord, save Thy people", and the Kontakion, "Now the flaming sword")

"Lord I Call..." Tone 7

Lord, I call upon You, hear me! Hear me, O Lord!
Lord, I call upon You, hear me!
Receive the voice of my prayer, when I call upon You!//
Hear me, O Lord!

Let my prayer arise in Your sight as incense, and let the lifting up of my hands be an evening sacrifice!//
Hear me, O Lord!

v. (10) Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Your name!

Tone 7 *(for the Resurrection)*

<u>Come</u>, let us rejoice in the Lord, Who de<u>stroyed</u> the do<u>minion</u> of death! Let us <u>sing</u> to Him with the <u>bodiless</u> hosts, for He en<u>light</u>ened the race of <u>man</u>!// O our Maker and <u>Savior</u>, <u>glory</u> to You!

v. (9) The righteous will surround me; for You will deal bountifully with me.

You en<u>dured</u> the Cross and <u>bur</u>ial for our sake. By Your <u>death</u>, You destroyed <u>death</u> as God. We fall <u>down</u> before Your Resurrection on the <u>third</u> day,//O <u>Savior</u>, <u>glory</u> to You!

v. (8) Out of the depths I cry to You, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice!

When the A<u>pos</u>tles beheld the Resurrection of the <u>Maker</u>, they were a<u>mazed</u> and sang the angelic praise.

<u>This</u> is the <u>glory</u> of the Church.

<u>This</u> is the richness of the <u>Kingdom.//</u>

O Lord, crucified for our <u>sake</u>, <u>glory</u> to You!

v. (7) Let Your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!

(Resurrection stichera by Anatolius)

You were <u>held</u> by lawless <u>men</u>, O Christ, but to <u>me</u>, You are God, and I am <u>not</u> ashamed.
You were <u>smitten</u> on the cheek, but I do not de<u>ny</u> You.
You were <u>nailed</u> to the Cross and I do not con<u>ceal</u> it, for I <u>glory</u> in Your Resurrection: Your <u>death</u> is my life.// O Almighty Lord and Lover of man, <u>glory</u> to You!

v. (6) If You, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You.

Fulfilling the prophecy of <u>David</u>,

<u>Christ</u> manifested His greatness in Zion to the disciples.

He is <u>praised</u> and always <u>glorified</u>,

together with the Father and the Holy <u>Spirit</u>.

At <u>first</u> as the Word, He was <u>bodiless</u>,

but <u>then</u> He took flesh and was <u>slain</u> for our sake.//

He rose in power as the <u>Lover of man!</u>

v. (5) For Your name's sake I have waited for You, O Lord, my soul has waited for Your word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

You descended into hell as You willed, O Christ, overthrowing death as God, and rising on the third day as Master! With Yourself You raised Adam from the bonds of hell and from corruption!//
Glory to Your Resurrection, only Lover of man!

v. (4) From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord!

Tone 5* (from the Lenten Triodion) (Rejoice, O ascetics)

Shine, O Cross of the Lord!

Illumine the hearts of those who honor you!

With love inspired by God, we embrace you, for you are the only hope of the world.

Through you our tears are wiped away, the snares of death are sprung, and we pass over into everlasting joy.

Through the Cross reveal Your beauty to us, O Lord!

Help Your servants who ask for mercy in faith!//

Bestow upon us the fruits of abstinence!

v. (3) For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities.

Rejoice, O life-bearing Cross:
bright paradise of the Church, the tree of incorruption!
You have obtained for us the joy of everlasting glory.
Through you, the hosts of demons are driven out;
the choirs of Angels are amazed and rejoice;
the company of the faithful gathers in celebration.
O unconquerable weapon, unbroken stronghold,
triumph of Orthodox Christians and pride of priests,//
by following you may we witness the Passion and Resurrection
of Christ our God!

v. (2) Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!

Rejoice, O life-bearing Cross: invincible triumph of godliness, gate of Paradise, and protection of the faithful!

The Cross is the might of the Church, through which corruption is abolished, through which the power of death is crushed. and we are raised from earth to heaven.

O invincible weapon, the adversary of demons, the glory of martyrs, the true adornment of ven'rable saints, and the haven of salvation,// which grants the world great mercy.

v. (1) For His mercy is abundant towards us; and the truth of the Lord endures forever.

Come, O Adam and Eve, our first father and mother, you fell from divine glory through the envy of the murderer of man!

Bitter was the pleasure of the Tree of old; but see, the honored Tree of the Cross draws near!

Run with haste and embrace it in joy, crying out with faith:

"You are our help, O most-precious Cross!

We eat your fruit and gain incorruption!//

We are restored again to Eden, having received great mercy!"

Tone 3 (from the Lenten Triodion)

Wishing to restore all men to life,
You accepted crucifixion, O Christ our God.
Burning with boundless love for man,
You took the quill of the Cross in Your hand;
dipping it in ink of royal crimson,
You signed our release with blood-stained fingers.
Though temptations as a sault us,
may we never for sake You again!
Have mercy on Your despairing people,
O long-suffering Master!//
Arise and fight Your enemies in Your almighty power!
now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Tone 7 (*Theotokion – Dogmatikon*)

No tongue can speak of your wonderful childbearing, for the order of nature was overruled by God. You were revealed to be a Mother above nature, for you remained a Virgin beyond reason and understanding. Your conception was most glorious, O Theotokos! The manner of your giving birth was ineffable, O Virgin! Knowing you to be the Mother of God, devoutly we pray to you://
"Beseech Him to save our souls!"

Tone 7

(for the Resurrection)

As the <u>Savior</u> of the world You a<u>rose</u> from the tomb. As <u>God</u> You resurrected the race of <u>man</u> with Your flesh.// O <u>Lord</u>, <u>glory</u> to You!

v. The Lord is King; He is robed in majesty!

<u>Come</u>, let us worship the One Who <u>rose</u> from the dead, and en<u>light</u>ened all creation!

By His <u>death</u>, He saved us from the <u>tor</u>ments of hell.//

By His Resurrection He has granted us eternal <u>life</u> and great <u>mer</u>cy.

v. For He has established the world, so that it shall never be moved.

You descended into hell, capturing death, O Christ. In three days You arose again, resurrecting us who glorify Your Resurrection,// O Lord and Lover of man.

v. Holiness befits Your house, O Lord, forevermore!

When You were placed in the tomb as one asleep, the sight was great and awesome.
But when You rose on the third day as almighty God, You resurrected Adam with Yourself.//
Glory to Your Resurrection, only Lover of man!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Tone 4 (from the Lenten Triodion)

The humble <u>Da</u>vid defeated his enemies by Your <u>help</u>, O Lord.

Now <u>come</u> to the aid of Your Orthodox <u>people</u>; show us Your power as You <u>did</u> of old, and our adversaries will <u>know</u> that <u>You</u> are God! And we will be victorious, for we <u>hope</u> in You.

Through the constant intercessions of Your all-pure <u>Mother</u>,//grant us Your great <u>mer</u>cy!

(at Great Vespers)

Tone 7 Troparion (Resurrection)

By Your <u>Cross</u> You destroyed <u>death</u>.

To the thief You opened <u>Paradise</u>.

For the <u>Myrrh</u>bearers You changed weeping into joy. And You commanded Your disciples, O <u>Christ</u> God, to pro<u>claim</u> that You are <u>risen</u>,// granting the <u>world</u> great <u>mer</u>cy.

Tone 1 Troparion of the Cross

Tone 1 Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion

When <u>Ga</u>briel announced to you, O Virgin, saying "Rejoice!" with that word the Master of all was incarnate in <u>You</u>, the holy Ark, spoken of by the righteous <u>Da</u>vid!

Your <u>womb</u> became more spacious than the <u>heavens</u>, for you carried your Creator.

<u>Glory</u> to Him Who took a<u>bode</u> in you!

Glory to Him Who came <u>forth</u> from you!//

Glory to Him Who freed us by being <u>born</u> of you!
