"I believe" From Fr. Schmemmann's *Celebration of Faith*, focusing on the Creed

"After confessing the holiness of the Church, we confess the Church's *catholicity*. The word "catholic" means firstly that which is worldwide, universal, and secondly, wholeness and fullness. The Church is universal because Christ and His teaching are addressed not to any one people, nor to one particular era or culture, but to all mankind, to all cultures and to all eras. ... Christ says: 'Go into all the world, and preach the Gospel to the whole creation' (Mark 16:15) ... the teaching of Christ is an *organic whole*, which means that it is all-encompassing, embracing within itself the whole life of man, answering all his questions, directed to *all of life*. ... In saying the Church is apostolic, it was founded upon those apostles chosen and instructed by Christ Himself, and secondly that it remains missionary, i.e., doing the work of Christ in the world."
