Feast of the Meeting of the Lord in the Temple

"The Christmas-Epiphany season comes to an end with this feast, forty days after the feast of the Savior's birth. ... The conclusion of this festival brings to a close the liturgical cycle which began at the beginning of the Christmas fast.

When the Lord Jesus is brought by His parents to the woman Anna. This meeting is spiritually and theologically significant. It tells us that the two covenants have now met: Israel has accomplished its God-given task in producing the Messiah. The promises made to Abraham in the beginning of the nation's calling have now been fulfilled. Israel's glory has dawned in the person of Christ who is now encountered in the world as the 'light of revelation to the Gentiles.' In Him the whole world is illumined and saved." Week of Feb. 9: Fast Free Week, all week

Week of Feb. 16: back to regular fasting Wednesday and Friday

Sunday, Feb. 23: Meatfare Sunday, last day to eat meat, dairy products allowed all week Sunday, March 2: Cheesefare Sunday, last day to eat dairy products. **Forgiveness Vespers**

Monday, March 3: Great Lent begins with Clean Week (Triodion, p. 35)

Please begin planning <u>now</u> for the beginning of Great Lent: **Forgiveness Sunday Vespers** will be celebrated on **March 2**nd after coffee hour. We begin the first week of the Great Lenten journey with the celebration of the Service of **Great Compline and the Canon of St. Andrew**. This service is integral to our entrance into Great Lent. Please make every effort to attend these services.
