Monday, March 3: Great Lent begins with Clean Week (Triodion, p. 35)

Please begin planning <u>now</u> for the beginning of Great Lent: **Forgiveness Sunday Vespers** will be celebrated on **March 2**<sup>nd</sup> after coffee hour. We begin the first week of the Great Lenten journey with the celebration of the Service of **Great Compline and the Canon of St. Andrew**. This service is integral to our entrance into Great Lent. Please make every effort to attend these services.

**Lenten Mission Vespers** are celebrated at various parishes in our deanery and across the Fellowship of Orthodox Churches of CT (FORCC) on Sunday afternoons during Great Lent. This is a great opportunity to visit other local parishes, and to pray with our brothers and sisters during the Great Lenten journey. These services will be posted on our website, and here each Sunday.

## Confessions

As has been the practice over many years, when you come to confession during Great Lent, please remember to sign the confession book that will be available. Please don't wait until the end of lent to make time for your confession. We will <u>not</u> be celebrating general confession until after Pascha.

## Forgiveness Sunday:

"the Expulsion of Adam from the Paradise of Bliss." This name summarizes indeed the entire preparation for Lent. By now we know that man was created for paradise, for knowledge of God and communion with Him. Man's sin has deprived him of that blessed life and his existence on earth is exile. Christ, the Savior of the world, opens the door of paradise to everyone who follows Him, and the Church, by revealing to us the beauty of the Kingdom, makes our life a pilgrimage toward our heavenly fatherland. Lent is the liberation of our enslavement to sin, from the prion of 'this world.' And the Gospel lesson (Matt. 6:14-21) sets the conditions for that liberation.
