Confessions

As has been the practice over many years, when you come to confession during Great Lent, please remember to sign the confession book that will be available. Please don't wait until the end of lent to make time for your confession. We will <u>not</u> be celebrating general confession until after Pascha.

Lenten Mission Vespers are celebrated at various parishes in our deanery and across the Fellowship of Orthodox Churches of CT (FORCC) on Sunday afternoons during Great Lent. This is a great opportunity to visit other local parishes, and to pray with our brothers and sisters during the Great Lenten journey. These services will be posted on our website, and here each Sunday.

* Anniversary Commemoration: Friday March 14 is the commemoration of St. Benedict, and the 15th Anniversary of the Ordination of His Grace, our Bishop Benedict to the Holy Priesthood. We hope to celebrate with His Grace by praying the Liturgy of Pre-Sanctified Gifts at 6:30 pm on Thursday evening March 13th at Ss. Peter and Paul Orthodox Church in Meriden CT. The Diocesan Choir will be singing the responses, but others are invited to join in if they wish.

St.Gregory Palamas: Is remembered on the Second Sunday of Great Lent, after a Synod was held in 1341, in Constantinople, exonerating him. From the proceedings of this Synod, Barlaam the Calabrian came to a community of monks on Mount Athos, sharing his own thoughts about the ability to perceive the essence of God rationally. Later he turned and accused the same monks of these false teachings, identifying St. Gregory Palamas directly. St. Gregory defended the right theological understanding that we cannot know God's essence, but we can participate in His Divine energy, revealed through the Grace of the Holy Spirit. His defense was a written work entitled: *Triads in defense of the Holy Hesychasts*. His arguments were then presented at the synod in 1341, and in a Hagioritic Tome, the abbots from monasteries on Mount Athos signed their agreement with St. Gregory's arguments, and his practice of stillness in prayer that had already been known for centuries. As the Sunday of Orthodoxy celebrates the icons in the midst of the church, this second Sunday affirms the life of stillness in knowing God through prayer.
